Emagine Accomplishments

- Staff has followed a cohort of students over 4 years

Emagine aims to improve post secondary education enrollment for high school students by increasing academic proficiency, developing habits of successful behavior, fostering and engaging family support and exploring students passions.

Emagine's History

Emagine was founded by Oliver Sicut in 2002 to help students prepare for college acceptance and success during their high school years. Oliver Sicut organized after school programs in Orange County, CA and Los Angeles, CA before establishing Emagine in Boston, MA. He developed a pilot program while attending Harvard University where he mastered in Education. Oliver piloted the Emagine program at Madison Park TVHS where he was hired to teach math.

Our Four-Dimensional Approach

Increasing Academic Proficiency

Emagine students work in various programs to develop a strong understanding of mathematics, techniques to read with comprehension and write with clarity.

Developing Habits of Successful Behavior

Students who complete the program will develop nine specific habits to help students handle difficult situations on their own. Preparing students mentally for college is equally important for Emagine.

Fostering and Engaging Family Support

Surround students with multiple support systems allows for students to access numerous resources needed for successful enrollment into college.
